## Building and Connecting Urban Bee-aware Cities in Europe.

### OBJECTIVES

The **BeePathNet** project has been selected under the framework of the Urbact III programme Transfer Network call and it is developed on a 2 phases scheme: during Phase 1 (first **6 months**), Its main goal is to set up a **Transfrability Study** that allows the pilot cities to explore the potential, in their area, of and implementing strategic and sustainable action plans for urban beekeeping and to enlarge the BeePath network

During the Phase II (**24 months**) A working local group (ULG:Urbact Local Group) is set up, formed by the main stakeholders in the sector, who will share their vision on urban beekeeping, so as to be able to suggest concrete actions to adapt and transfer BeePathNet's good practices to the Cesena's territory.

### ACTIONS

The realisation of phase 1 of the project will be done through the following actions:

1. Compliance with all contractual obligations and performance of the administrative and financial management tasks;
2. The realization of a launching seminar (kick-off meeting) and a Transfer city visit in Cesena (May and June 2018) and Phase I final meeting participation in Ljubljana (SI, August 2018);
3. Identification of strenght and needs on urban beekeeping in each of the partner cities;
4. Set up and coordination of a Urbact Local action Group (ULG)
5. Participation of several ULG representatives to the international bootcamp meeting in Ljubljana (April 2019) and organization of a transfer city visit in Cesena (March 2020);
6. Set up of a long term action plan for the implementation and transfer of the Ljubljana's best practice to the city of Cesena.
