Project: the project (funded by the European programa URBACT II) had the objective of disseminating knowledge about interventions for the most innovative energy efficiency in cities through urban planning, design choices and construction of buildings, energy resources and technologies . The project aimed in particular to establishing local plans for analyzing and comparing the energy efficiency measures and actions to arrive at a definition of government incentives and schemes in line with the urban riots of energy efficiency strategies.

Results:

- Baseline study of European policies and projects on energy efficiency in cities and profile of each partner (national regulatory framework, national energy policies, regional and local energy balance, organization and related projects);
- Organize an Energy Day in Cesena for the launch of work on municipal energy plan: conference and workshops with the participation of stakeholders of the territory.
